Fly inverted straight flight for a minimum of 5 seconds at approximately 60 feet with rollout to upright flight. Perform an upright 2½ turn spin, exit to upright. | Slow roll in either direction. Inverted 2½ turn spin, exit to inverted. Stall turn with ¼ rolls on the ascent and descent, exit upright. (Stall turn to be done with underside of model towards the pilot.) Hourglass with half roll in top line. Fly inverted straight flight for a minimum of 5 seconds at approximately 30 feet with one roll from inverted to inverted. Perform an inverted 2½ turn spin, exit to inverted. |

All entrants will be judged on each element they complete with the total score divided by the number of elements completed for a final score. Each pilot must complete all items from Group A and in addition: -

Novice (but competent): 1 item from Group B
Experienced/ 'A' certified: 3 items from Group B and 1 from Group C
Accomplished/ 'B' certified: 3 items from Group B and 3 from Group C
Expert/ 'C': All items from Group B and 4 from Group C

In addition you must also tell the judge your intended order of elements and you are allowed one refuel/battery change during your display provided you advise the judge of this prior to take off (the first take off and second landing will be awarded points)
